



Research Study at University of Wisconsin - Milwaukee

Dr. Hanjoo Lee from the Psychology Clinic at the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee (2441 E Hartford Ave. Milwaukee, WI53211) is recruiting children /adolescents aged between 9 and 17, who experience moderate to severe tic symptoms, for a treatment study.

This study examines whether a computer-based cognitive training program can improve the effects of behavior therapy for Tourette Syndrome/tic disorders.

Participants will receive 8 computer-based cognitive training sessions in addition to 8 weekly behavior therapy sessions, with clinical evaluation before, during, and after the treatment.
